JUDGE: W. Robert Fawke [Proposed] AMENDED JUDGMENT Default Prove-Up: July 27, 2009

(collectively the "Class") Default Prove-Up hearing as to Defendant CHUDHARY RAFIQ AHMAD, doing business as INTERNATIONAL HOUSE OF PANCAKES (Defendant Chudary Rafiq Ahmad), came on regularly for hearing at 9:00 a.m., on July 27, 2009, in Department S-38 of the San Bernardino County Superior Court in connection with the above-captioned matter.

Robert W. Skripko, Jr., Esq. of the Law Office of Robert W. Skripko, Jr., APLC, and Timothy D. Otte, Esq., appeared on behalf of the Class at said hearing. No other party entered an appearance thereat.

Having considered and weighed all admissible evidence and disregarding all inadmissible evidence, witness testimony, and applying all governing statutory authority and applicable case precedent relative thereto, findings of fact and conclusions of law, judgment is hereby found and awarded in this matter as follows:

There exists a well-defined community of interest among the Plaintiff class members since there are:

- common questions of law and fact that predominate over questions affecting individual members:
- (2) the Class Representative, Chastdei Kotsay, has claims that are typical of the class and;
- (3) there exists in Ms. Kotsay adequate representation of the class.

On the Complaint, in favor of the Class and against Defendant Chudhary Rafiq Ahmad as follows:

- 1. Defendant Chudhary Rafiq Ahmad deliberately and illegally deducted one half hour of wages from each class member's shift (Labor Code §226) and damages are awarded thereon to the Class in the amount of \$141,252.26;
- 2. Defendant Chudhary Rafiq Ahmad misrepresented to the class members the actual hours worked by each class member in violation of Labor Code §226 and thereon awards damages in the amount of ZERO
- Defendant Chudhary Rafiq Ahmad deliberately did not pay all overtime wages earned by the class members in violation of Labor Code §510 and damages are awarded thereon to the Class in the amount of \$495,804.00;
- 4. Defendant Chudhary Rafiq Ahmad deliberately did not permit the class members to take their statutorily required thirty-minute meal periods in violation of Labor Code §512, Wage Order No. 5, section 11 and damages are awarded thereon to the Class in the amount of \$282,504.53;
- 5. Defendant Chudhary Rafiq Ahmad deliberately did not permit the class members to take their statutorily required ten-minute rest periods in violation of Wage Order No. 5, section 12 and damages are awarded thereon to the Class in the amount of \$282,504.53;
- 6. Defendant Chudhary Rafiq Ahmad did not provide and maintain for the class members uniforms and equipment which Defendant required the class members to utilize in violation of Labor Code §450, IWC Orders, Section 7, Sec. 9(A) and damages are awarded thereon to the Class in the amount of \$44,512.88;
